


Solid Connections Programs 1 & 2

About the Programs

The Solid Connections Programs 1 & 2 aims to provide Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander applicants with an opportunity to discover new skills and explore career pathways in the Aboriginal Health Care and Support Workforce.

During the programs

- Applicants will be assisted to meet the minimum requirements prior to being enrolled in any formal training or employment. This can include gathering identification and certificates such as birth certificates, police clearances and photo identification.
- Explore career pathways in Aged Care Services, Disability Support Services and Aboriginal Health Care.
- Be supported in a culturally safe learning environment.
